

MGB and Inova Young Investigator's Award in Women's Cardiovascular Health 2025

Dear Young Investigator,

The Massachusetts General Hospital and Inova's Women's Heart Health Programs invite you to present your work in our inaugural Young Investigator Award. We are seeking abstract submissions for research on cardiovascular disease in women.

Eligibility:

- We invite all medical trainees (from medical students, residents, and fellows) as well as early career faculty (within 3 years of final training completion) to participate.
- You must be able to travel to Boston, Massachusetts on Friday, May 9, 2025, if selected to participate in the final competition round. Travel for the top 3 finalists will be reimbursed up to \$1,500.

Abstract requirements:

1. You must present original research for which you are the first author
2. You may present either unpublished or published work
3. Please limit your submission to 2,000 characters (excluding authors and clinical implications)
4. You may choose to submit a single figure
5. Please follow the following format:

Title

Authors: The first author should be the submitting young investigator. All other authors involved in the study must be included. The final author should be the senior author/mentor for the project. All author institutions should also be included in the author block.

Background: 1-2 sentences that provide background on the purpose of the study

Methods: Briefly state the methods used including statistical method

Results: Summarize the main primary and key secondary results

Conclusion

Clinical implications: Please include 1-2 sentences in this section

Competition Process:

- Only complete applications will be considered. Please submit your abstract by January 1, 2025, via e-mail to Liz Henry (ehenry6@mgh.harvard.edu) and attach your submission as a Microsoft Word document.
- All abstracts will be reviewed, and successful investigations will be invited to present in a first competition round virtually. Details will be sent at the time of notification to invited participants.
- Competition finalists will be invited to present their work at a live competition in Boston, Massachusetts on Friday, May 9, 2025.
- The competition winner will be recognized and engage in a mentorship program in Women's Heart Health with one of our senior judges.
